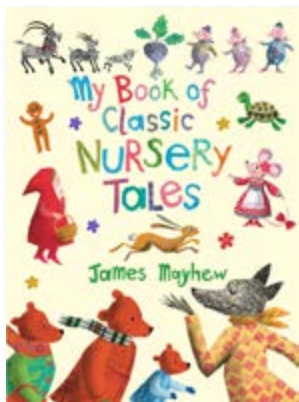

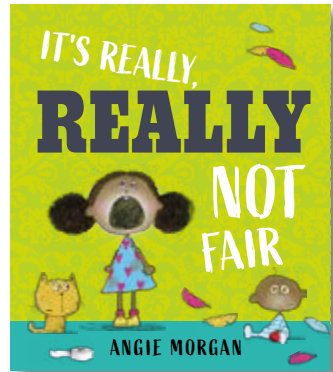

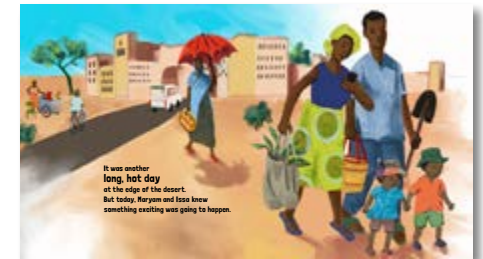

He illustrated Valerie Bloom's *Stars With Flaming Tails*, winner of the 2021 CLIPPA Award, and has been nominated for the Astrid Lindgren Award and the Carnegie/Kate Greenaway Medal. For Otter-Barry Books he has written and illustrated *Astro Girl*, *Eco Girl* and *Aqua Boy*. He lives in North London.

Ming the Panda

A mother tells her child a bedtime story – the true story of Ming the Giant Panda. Born in the mountains of Sichuan, Ming's life is traced from a tiny baby, growing up in the wild. Brought from China to London Zoo in 1938, she quickly becomes a favourite for visitors, especially children. Even Princess Elizabeth, the future Queen, comes to see her. And when the Second World War breaks out, Ming becomes an international celebrity, a symbol of hope in dangerous times.

When Ming dies in 1944 there is great sadness, but her story lives on, "helping to bring people together, shining light and giving hope." Told as a story within a story, with Yu Rong's evocative illustrations, Ming's story still resonates today.

JAKE HOPE is a former librarian who is now a writer, reviewer and consultant for the Carnegie Medals. He has judged or chaired numerous awards, including the Costa Children's Fiction Prize, and has been a jury member on the Bologna Ragazzi award. He is editor of and a contributor to *Our Rights! Stories and Poems About Children's Rights* (Otter-Barry Books, 2023). He lives in Preston, Lancashire.

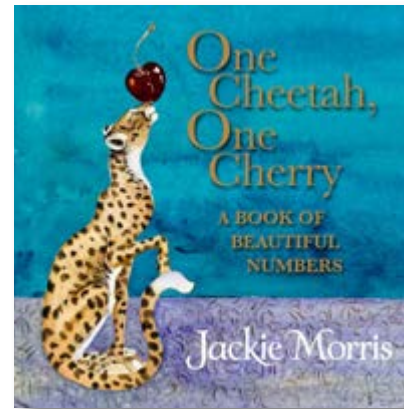

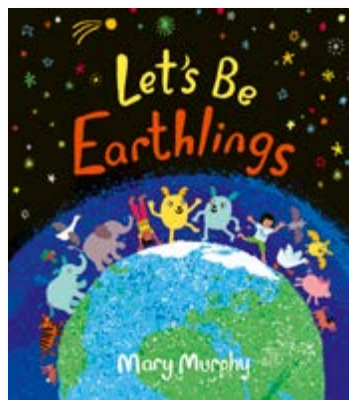

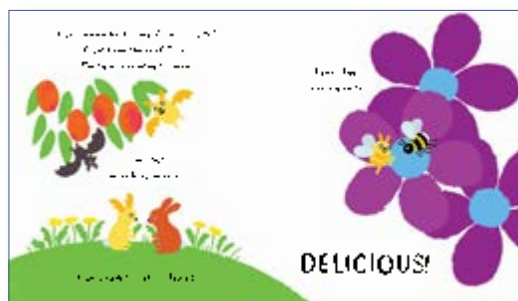

Mary Murphy's simple yet profound words and images show young children the beauty and diversity of life on Earth - and in doing so, help them understand that they need to look after our precious planet.



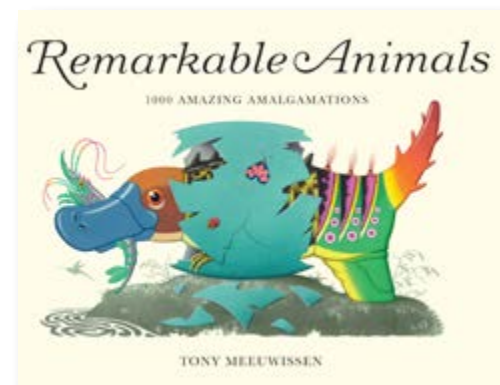
